## Red Alert: To all Bus Drivers....

**Electronic devices** are **NOT** to be used while bus is in motion or children are aboard the bus. If you need to use your phone make sure you are stopped in a safe location with **NO** children aboard. Any device that can distract you from driving is **NOT** permitted to be **USED** while the bus is in motion/children are on board.

Kindergarten Procedures must be followed at all times. All kindergarteners should have a green pass with students full name, grade level and drop off location, if they do not have this pass the school must give them a Campus Base Pass (bus pass), if the child does not have either one **DO NOT MOVE** the bus until you are supplied with one. Kindergarteners are to be seated in the front of the bus, and the designated adult picking up the child must be at the stop **NOT WAITING IN A CAR**. Before opening the door, ask each kindergarten student to point to their designated adult, after you establish a connection open the door and release the student. If the designated adult is not present at time of drop off notify your field office and dispatch that the child **MUST** be taken back to the school.

After 4:00 pm employee may use the After Hours Urgent Care Clinic on the list (for a copy of approved providers go to HSEF website at www.HSEFonline.org). However you must follow up with one of the initial care facilities.
- 3. Notify the doctor and medical staff that you were injured on the job so that bills may be properly filed. And for after hours you must provide Photo Id.
